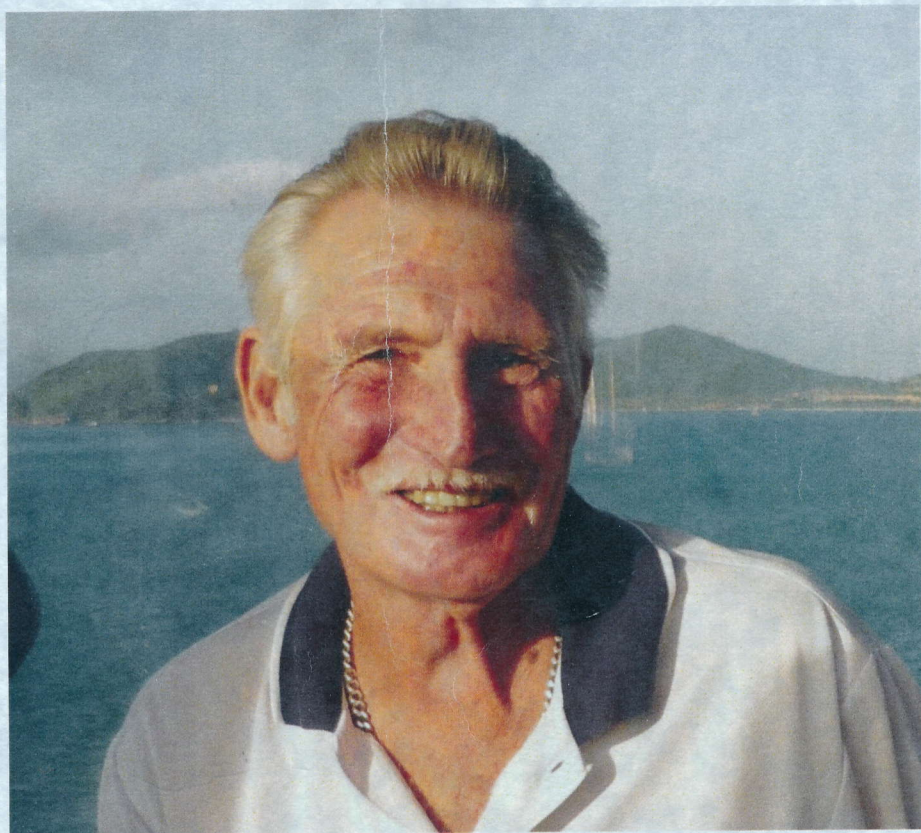

just from me.

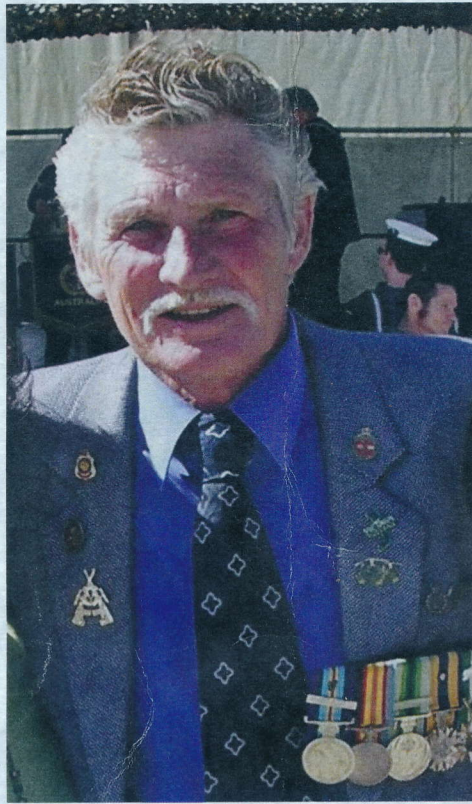
But mostly I treasured my family I knew, in a bond
